- □ School Education Plan Approval (4-year plan)

 Advancing student numeracy & literacy. Building future ready students.
Inclusive and engaging healthy learning opportunities for student. Use Alberta (provincial) and RVS assessments along with Elk Island assessments. PBAS program and school culture. (meeting for DEC. 4)

- Talk about 139 students with complex needs. Need to talk to MLA/Provincial trustee/Education minister to approve more funding as each school is allocated a certain amount depending on if a child is professionally assessed for this funding. Formula is allocated by the school board.

- □ Hour Zero- Fire Drills and Lock Downs
  - Kids are doing great in these lockdown drills. Some parent concern around down time after these for children who have high anxiety or some assistance after wards to calm down. Assured that there is down time to talk about these drills, but some may benefit from more discussion for assistance in areas. Suggested to have access to a counsellor after these.
